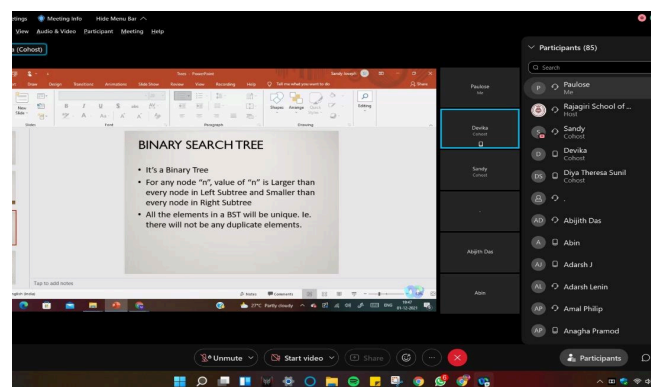
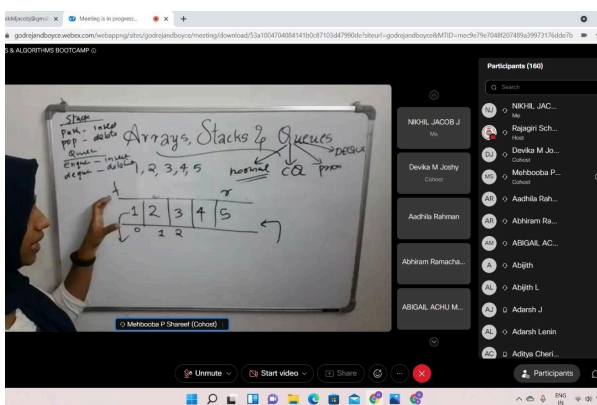
Technology Events

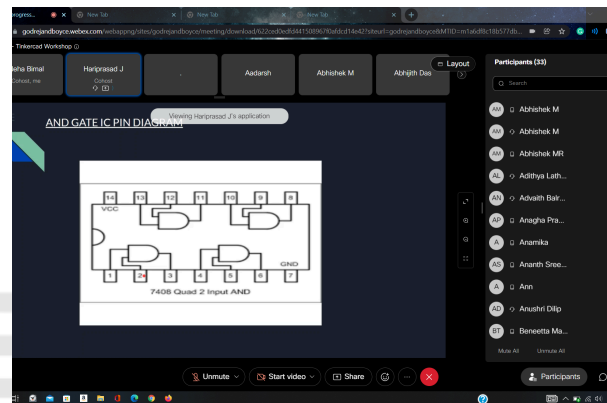
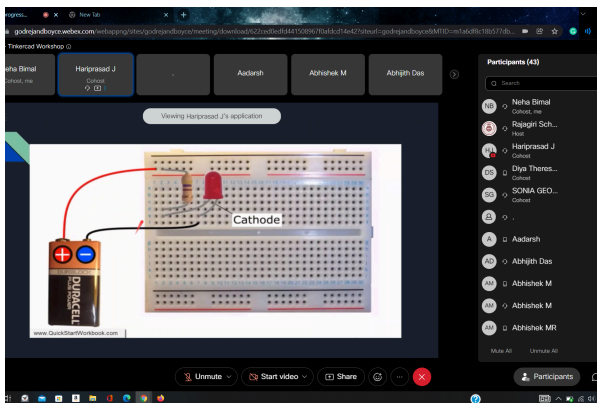
1. Data Structures and Algorithm Bootcamp

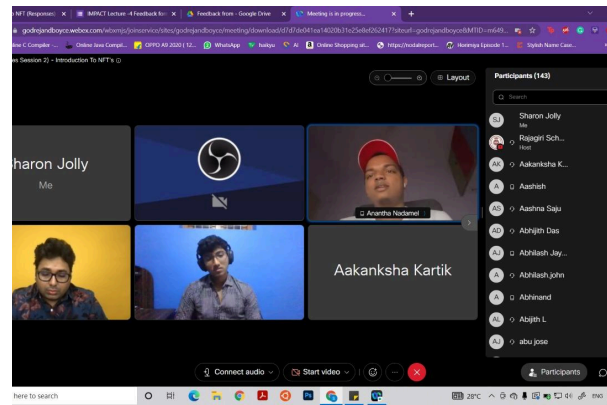
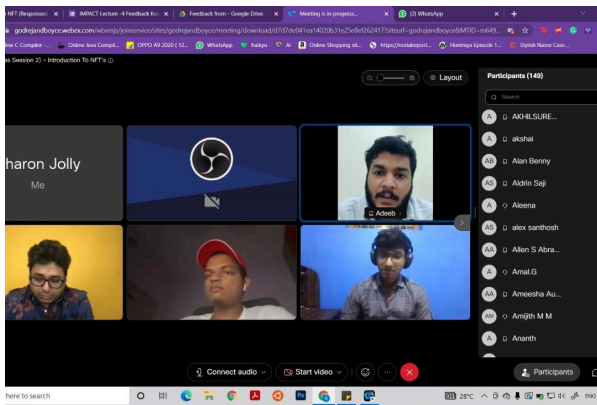
2. LET'S GO TINKER

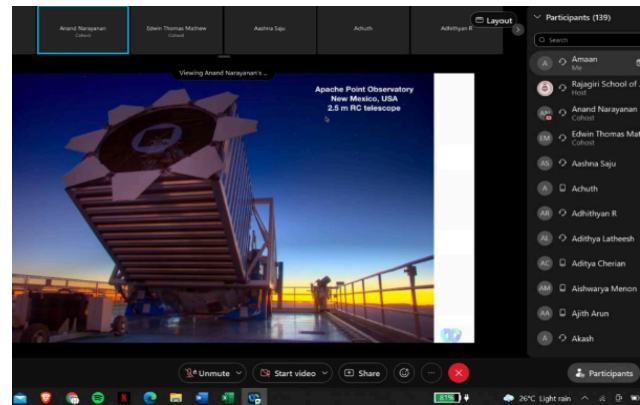
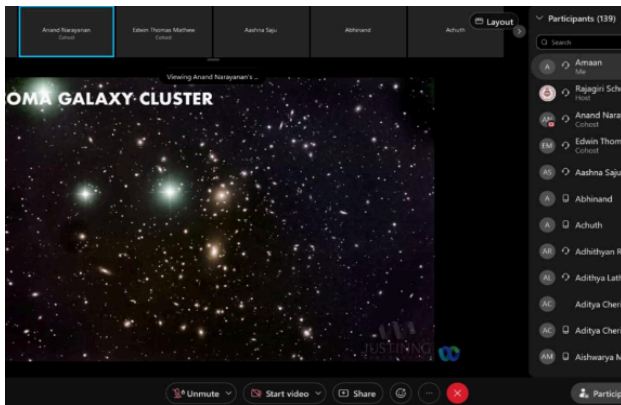


4. PROJ3CT AR3S

Three intriguing problem statements were provided, allowing participants to choose one that sparked their interest. The event kick-started on November 16th at 6 PM, with a recap of the rules and guidelines. Participants were then prompted to submit their entries through a separate Google form, with the deadline set for November 18th at 6 PM. Nine teams enthusiastically submitted a total of 9 creative and innovative solutions to the given challenges.

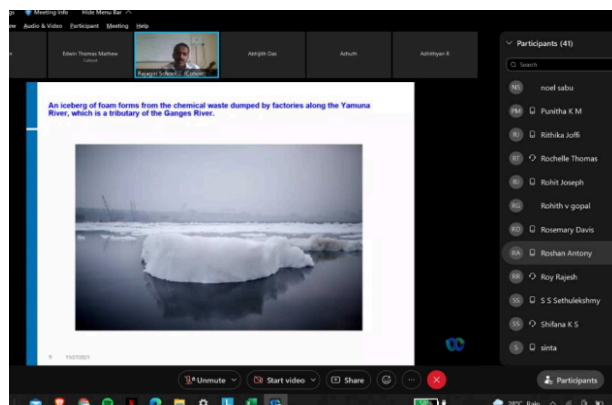
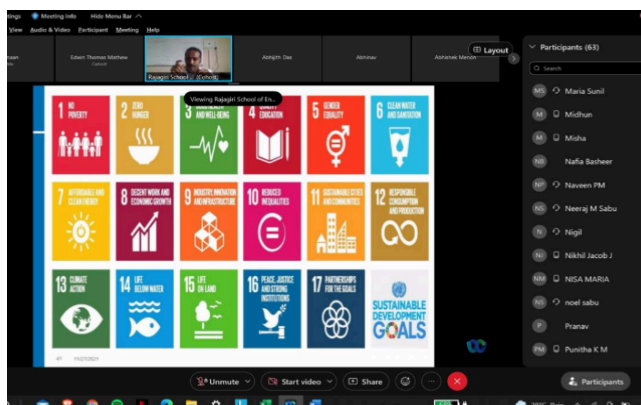
7. Introduction to Java

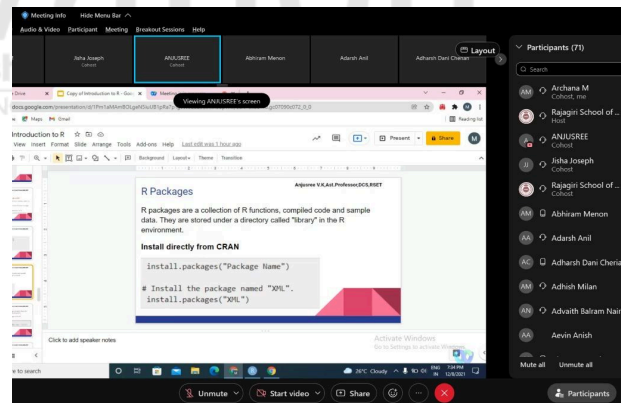
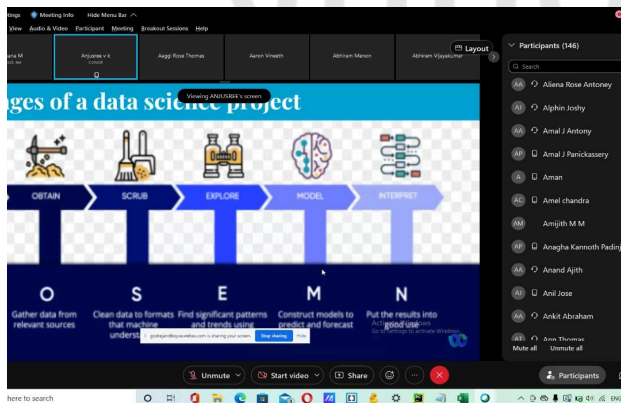
10. GRAB 3D

11. DATA MANIA

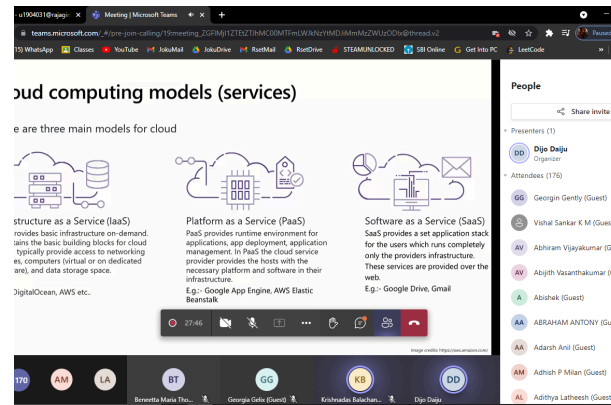
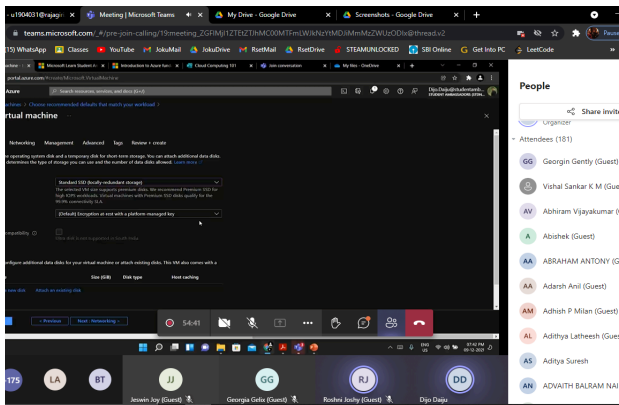

12. CLOUD COMPUTING 101

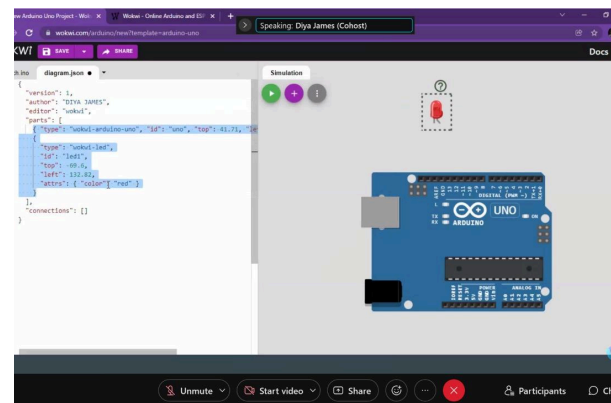
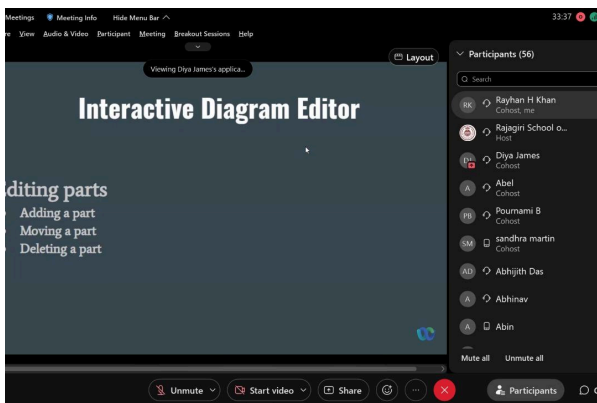

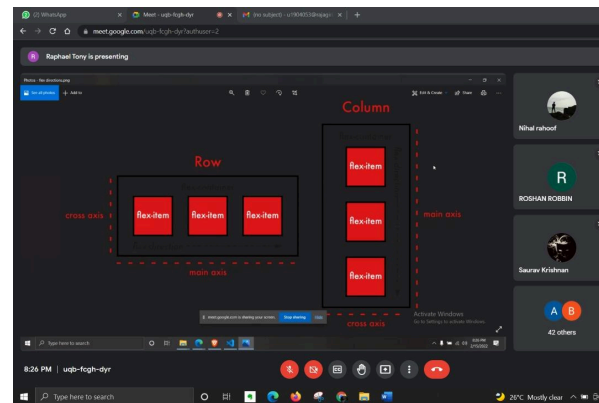
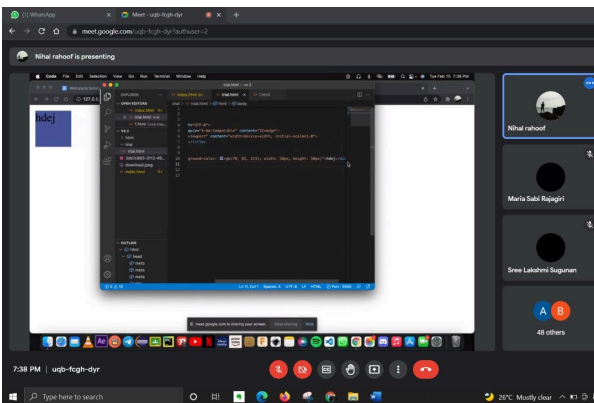
16.HackS'US1.5

17.WEBSPACE

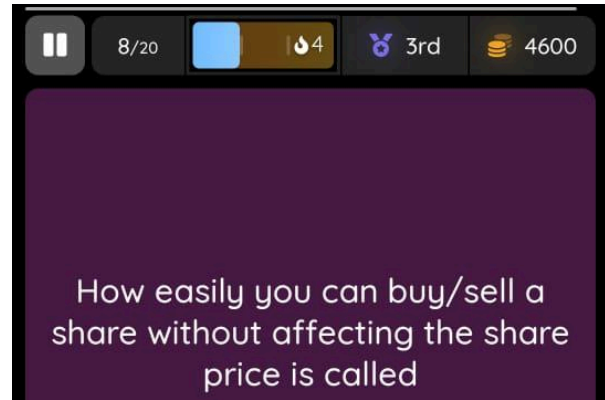
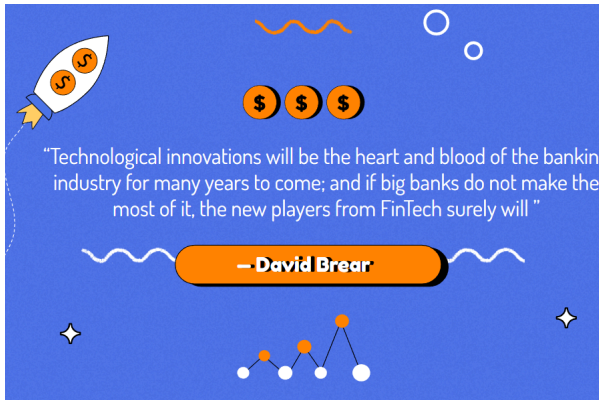

18.Finnovate

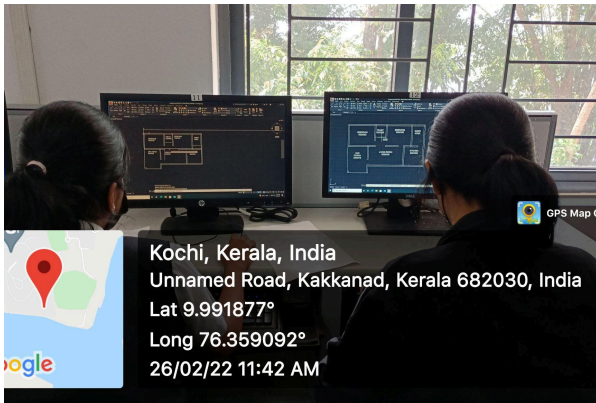

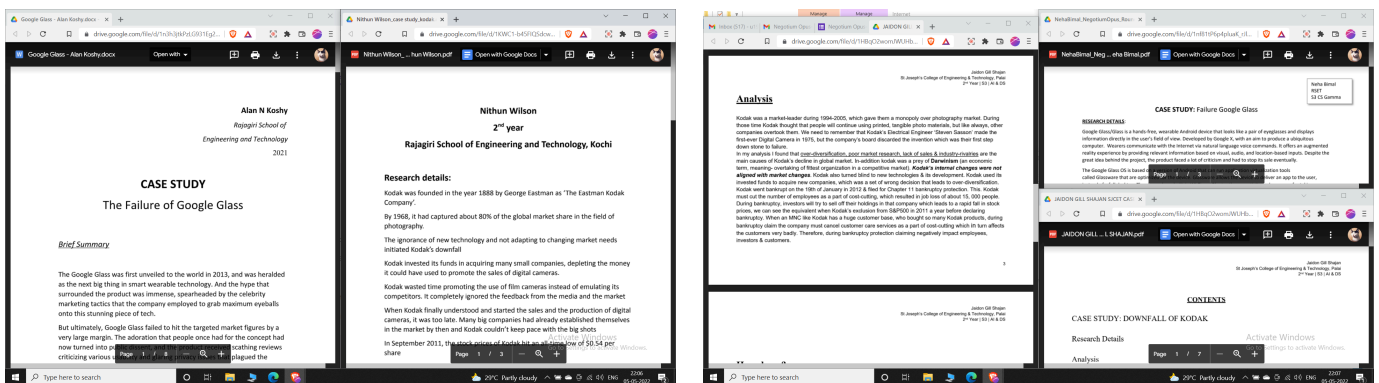


Entrepreneurship Events

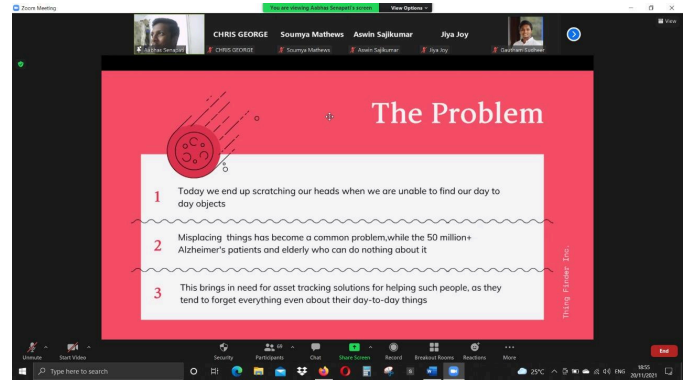
1. Negotium Opus

From December 18th to December 24th, the event was conducted with the aim of testing participants' entrepreneurial, accounting, and business knowledge, as well as their creativity and problem-solving skills in designing a product and finding solutions to a case study. The event comprised three rounds. Round 1 was conducted through Quizizz at 6:30 PM and initially scheduled to end at 7:30 PM, but due to technical issues, it was retaken from 7:40 PM to 8:30 PM. Out of the participants, 30 were selected to proceed to the next round. Round 2 involved a submission event, where participants were given a topic via email on December 19th, and they had until 8 PM on December 20th to submit their work. Due to popular demand, the deadline was extended to 8:30 PM. Nine individuals were selected from this round to advance to the final round. Round 3, the final round, was also a submission event. Participants received the topic via email on November 23rd at 7:30 PM, and the submission deadline was set for November 24th at 11:59 PM. Ultimately, three winners were chosen from this round based on their submissions.



2. Decoding Social Entrepreneurship Bootcamp

Decoding Social Entrepreneurship was a six day bootcamp on social entrepreneurship organized on zoom platform from November 20-25,2021 from 6:30 pm to 7:30 pm. In total we had six sessions. The coordinators of the program were Chris George of S7 ECE beta and Sonia George of S7 IT.

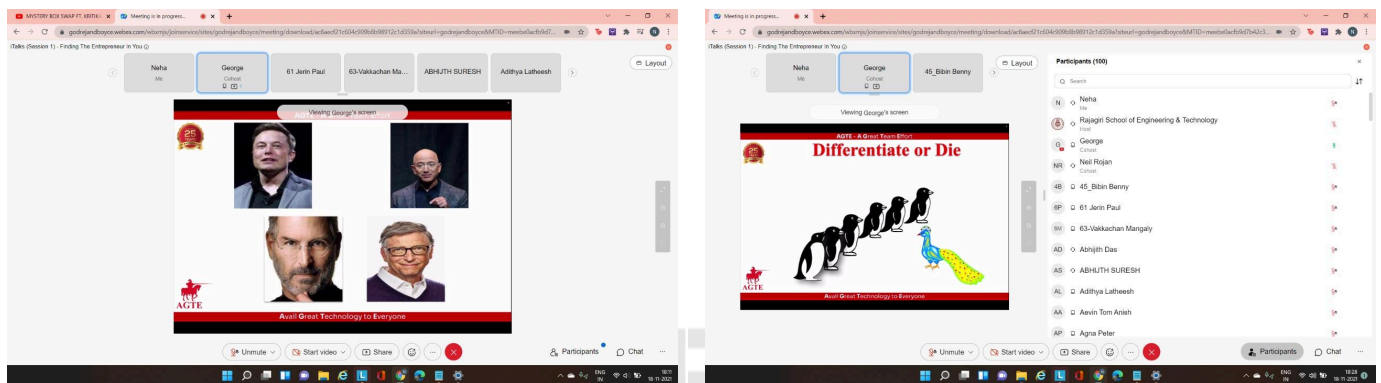
8. Legal aspects of setting up a startup and protecting your IP

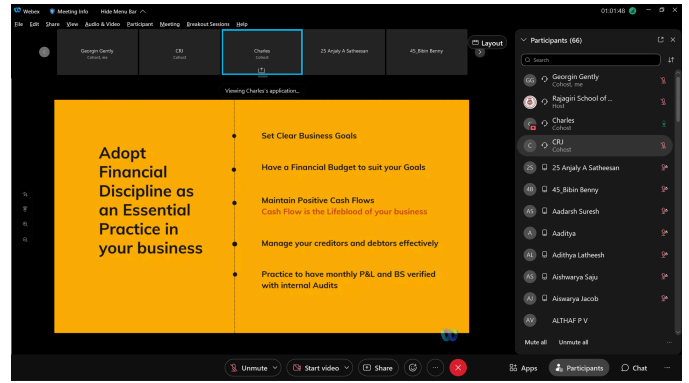
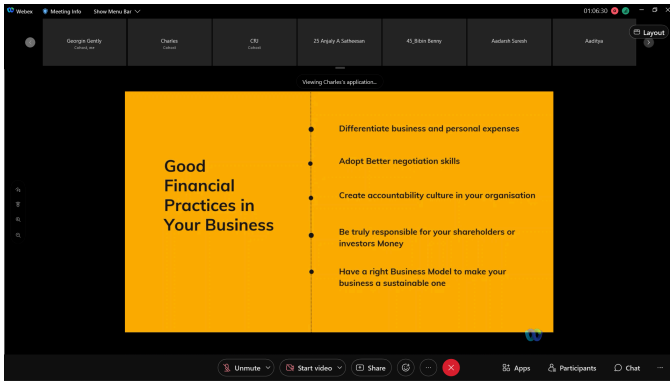

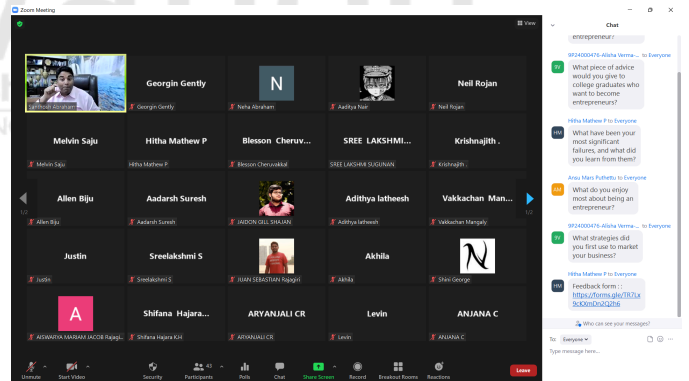

12. IT'S A DEAL

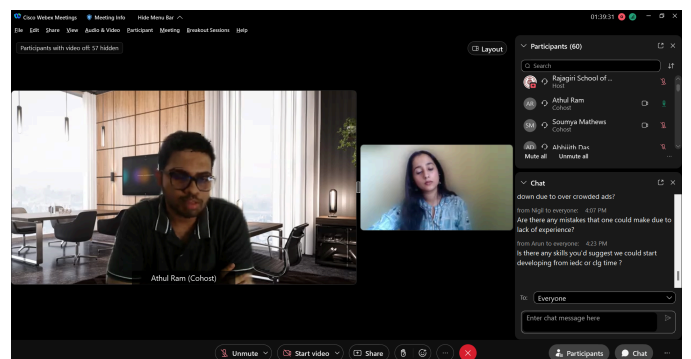
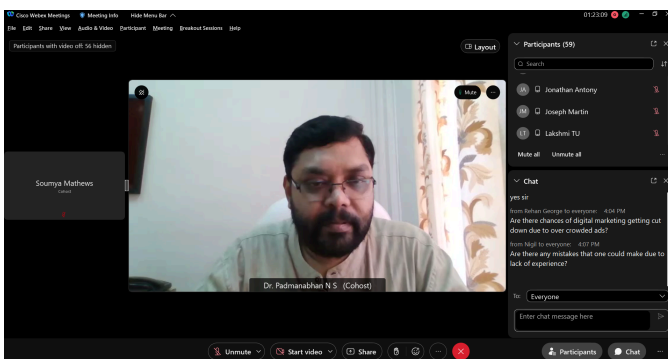

Roshan Sunny. The well-organized event's success was attributed to active participation, cooperation from judges, and dedicated organizers and volunteers, receiving positive feedback from students.



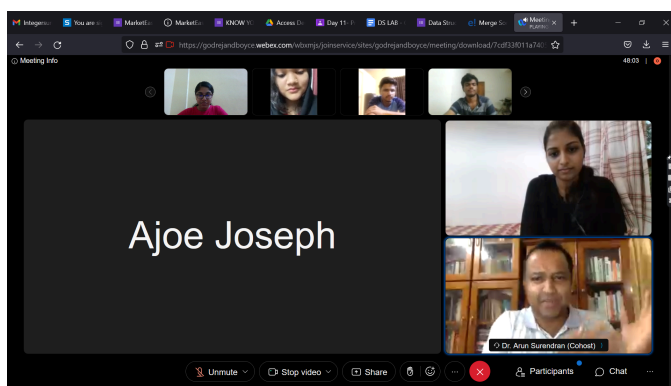
13.Set Sail

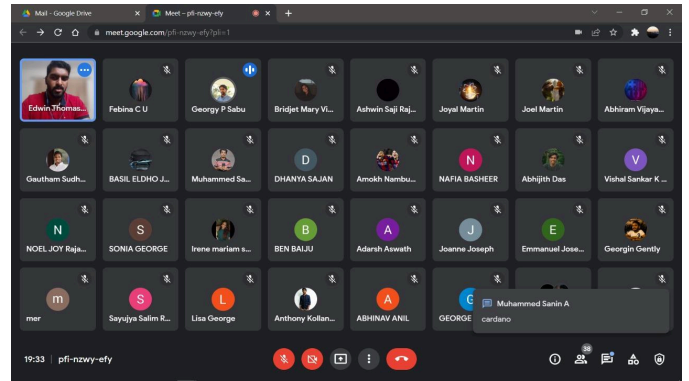
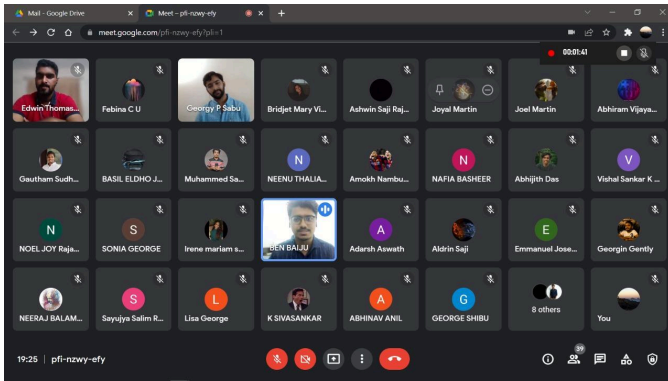
14. MarketEase

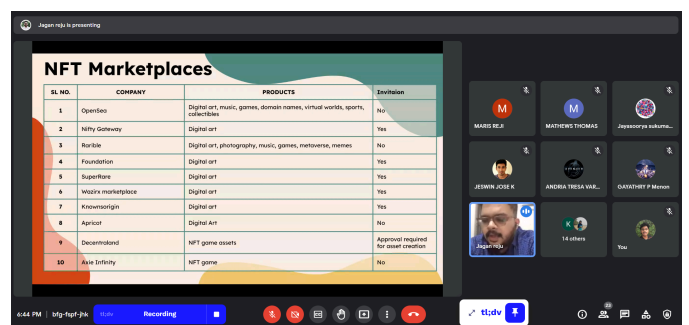
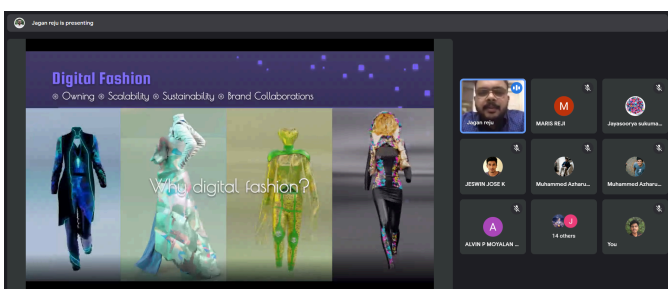
15. ENCRYPTO

16. THE COMPLETE NFT

The workshop was designed for individuals with any level of knowledge in NFTs. Day one covered the fundamental concepts of NFTs, blockchain, and crypto wallets, along with a brief history of NFTs. Day two focused on various NFT marketplaces and provided guidance on creating crypto wallets using different mainnets. Attendees received a walkthrough on listing their artwork on these marketplaces. Day three concluded with discussions about the future of NFTs and their potential widespread usage by large conglomerates. The resource persons for the workshop included Mr. Jagan Reju, an RSET alumnus and NFT brand strategist; Mr. Muhammed Azharudheen, an RSET alumnus and web3 developer with extensive experience in crypto mining; and Ms. Jumaana Ruzzel Muhammed, an RSET alumnus and NFT artist actively publishing artworks in prominent marketplaces like Wazirx and Foundation.



17. Startup Awareness & Leadership Training

The Start-Up Awareness and Leadership program, conducted by RSET IEDC in collaboration with Bhavan's Adharsha Vidyalaya on 17th and 18th March 2022, saw the participation of 28 students from Bhavan's and 13 speakers from RSET IEDC.
